There is a map on the previous page showing classroom layouts as well as lining up places on the playground and entrance and exit doors. I hope that this information will support you over the coming months with your child's transition to the next year group.

Early Years

Early Years pupils will enter and exit thought the single entrance door at the bottom of the playground steps and will have lining up spaces towards this area. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.10 am.

Year 1

Year 1 pupils will use the door at the bottom of the playground underneath the shelter to enter and exit the building. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.10 am.

Year 2

Year 2 classes will use the door at the bottom of the playground under the shelter to enter and exit the building. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.10 am.

Year 3

Year 3 classes will use the door at the top of the inspiration station to enter and exit the school. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.05 am.

Year 4

As before, the Years 4 pupils will enter and exit using the path and door past the changing rooms. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.05 am.

Year 5

The Year 5 pupils will enter using the door by the ICT suite and exit using the old front door. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.05 am.

Year 6

Year 6 pupils will enter and exit using the changing room corridor door. Pupils are to line up on the playground when the bell sounds at 9.05 am.

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
