Lent Rise School's plan to convert to MAT status and invite other schools to join in collaborative growth is in line with our Education Strategy. At Buckinghamshire Council, we are keen to ensure that there are enough MATs to ensure schools that wish to convert to academy status have choice and that there is sufficient capacity in the system to provide support to schools that require it. We have always welcomed the close relationship that Lent Rise has maintained with the Council since the school became an academy and would hope that this will continue if and when you make the decision to become a MAT.
We support the MAT as long as the following goals are paramount to the cause. To support academic progress and also mental health and wellbeing. To ensure reading is a priority as well as core subjects of English and Maths in general. To show equality and celebrate diversity through teaching of all faiths in RE.
