We all believe that a nursery school uniform is important for the following reasons:

- It looks smart and gives a sense of belonging
- It eliminates social problems caused by latest fashion fads
- It contributes to a feeling of pride within our school
- It can be worn for all activities including physical outside sessions

We ask that all children wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

We are aware of cost of uniform and therefore do not require uniform with logos on however, this is available should parents wish to purchase it.

Daily:

Polo shirt: red with or without school logo

Jumper: red - with or without logo

Bottoms: Leggings or Jogging bottoms grey or black

Shoes: trainers or black closed toe shoes

\*no sandals, loose fitting slip ons, crocs or similar soft soled shoes

For health and safety children in nursery should not wear jewellery.
